


Keep your pots near a sunny window and remember to water when soil is dry.




Sunflowers are amazing and beautiful. They are easy to grow and provide food and shelter for wildlife.







If there isn't any danger of frost and your seedlings are 15 cm tall, they are nearly ready to transplant outside. The first week take them outdoors during the day and return them indoors at night. Then plant outdoors





Buds form on the tops of the sunflowers.









Sow the sunflower seeds in peat-free seedling compost in fibre pots. Label and date. Germination takes about seven to ten days.

The Autumnal season brings cooler weather and shorter days. Sunflowers grow during hot weather and long sunny days.
